This microscale site monitors CO and PM<sub>2.5</sub>. It was established in 1998 to measure CO at the west entrance to Yellowstone National Park (YNP). The site was moved about ¼ mile further into YNP during the spring of 2008. Continuous PM<sub>2.5</sub> monitoring was added in 2003. The site is very close to the roadway and is surrounded by tall trees. Air flow at monitoring height is up and down the roadway. Results are relevant only to the immediate vicinity. This site is funded by the National Park Service. However, the site is operated to comply with EPA requirements.
