Program Requirements

- *Must be unemployed or underemployed
- *Must be 18 years of age
- *Must be able to test at a 8th grade reading level and 6th grade math level using the Test of Adult Basic Education
- *High School Diploma or HiSET/GED strongly recommended
- *Must have valid Montana Driver’s License with no outstanding fines or restrictions
- *Must sign a drug/alcohol policy
- *Must provide personal and/or professional references
- *Must complete a personal interview
