# **General Information**

- 1. Complete a separate application for each facility for which a certification is desired.
- 2. When necessary, provide additional information as an attachment to the application with the corresponding question.
- 3. If any information required for certification has previously been submitted to another Montana state agency, the applicant can identify the agency that has the information in the application. If, after reasonable efforts, DEQ is unable to obtain the information from the other agency, it will be requested from the applicant.
- 4. To ensure the timely issuance of a certification, DEQ suggests that a complete application be submitted on or before March 1 prior to the applicable tax year.
- 5. Upon request by the DEQ, an applicant is required to submit any additional supporting documentation that is required for certification.
