SUBJECT: BIENNIAL USED OIL REPORTING REMINDER

Department records show you have registered and are classified as: USED OIL PROCESSOR/RE-REFINER OR TRANSFER FACILITY STORING USED OIL GREATER THAN 35 DAYS

This report is required pursuant to the Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM). (ARM 17.53.113, no registration fees are assessed for this classification). ARM 17.53.1401 adopts, by reference, the used oil regulations set forth in the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). 40 CFR 279.57(b) requires used oil processors/re-refiners to submit a biennial report. In addition, 40 CFR 279.45 states, in part, "Transfer facilities that store used oil for more than 35 days are subject to regulation under Subpart F of this chapter." Therefore, used oil transporters who **store used oil more than 35 days**, and used oil processors/re-refiners, must submit (by March 1 of each even numbered year) a document which reports the following information concerning used oil activities during the previous calendar year:

- 1. The EPA Identification Number, name and address of the processor/re-refiner.
- 2. The calendar year covered by the report.
- 3. The quantities of used oil accepted for processing/re-refining and the manner in which the used oil was processed/re-refined, including the specific processes employed.

Subsequent biennial used oil reporting reminders will be sent electronically via e-mail, in an effort to be more efficient with resources and improve service. If you do not have an e-mail address that we can use for this purpose, then the report reminder will be sent via mail.
