TENORM Workgroup Meeting

- MDEQ has invited 10 people to participate on the TENORM workgroup to help finalize the revised draft rules.
- The workgroup is limited in size and includes participants from non-governmental organizations, industry, local government, science, and informed citizenry.
- The TENORM workgroup will gather in Billings, at the DNRC Building located at 2535 St. Johns Avenue. From 8:00-5:00, we will be in the "Hearing Room", with access through the front doors off St. Johns.
- The public is welcome to watch and add input at the end of the workgroup meeting at the discretion of the outside facilitator.

After the Workgroup Meeting

- The facilitator and DEQ staff will summarize discussion areas and make any necessary revisions to the proposed TENORM rules.
- This work product will be noticed to the Secretary of State as proposed rules and provide for the start of public comment.
- There will be a formal 30 or 60-day public comment period.
- Public hearings will be held in Helena and a to be determined location in eastern Montana.
