E-waste can be dropped off at the Billings Regional Landfill, 5240 Jellison Road, or Yellowstone E-Waste Solutions, 15 N. 15th Street. This program is for residential e-waste only. Business-generated e-waste can be recycled at Yellowstone E-Waste Solutions for a cost.</p> <p>Residential items accepted for recycling include all computers and accessories, TVs, microwaves, small kitchen appliances, stereo equipment, cell phones, power tools, rechargeable</p>
