PUBLIC NOTICE

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has issued the Record of Decision for the final remedy for cleanup of contamination at Mission Wye located outside of Livingston in Park County, Montana. The major components of the remedy are monitored natural attenuation for groundwater and institutional controls (ICs). ICs will include land use and groundwater restrictions on portions of Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway and Montana Rail Link properties. The remedy was selected over other alternatives evaluated because it meets statutory requirements and is expected to achieve substantial risk reduction in a cost-effective manner. The Record of Decision is available for public review at the DEQ Waste Management and Remediation Division, 1225 Cedar Street, Helena, the Livingston-Park County Public Library, 228 W Callender St, Livingston.
