- 1) The Department of Environmental Quality is inviting public comment on two administrative request submissions to the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to exclude certain ambient air monitoring data from regulatory review.
- 2) The first submission is for certain PM₁₀ ambient air monitoring data from 2018 that were flagged for exclusion because their values were affected (i.e. increased) due to smoke from wildfires. The documentation contains information regarding the monitoring data "flagged" for exclusion. After review, EPA may exclude the flagged data for purposes of air quality planning and regulation.
- 3) The second submission is for PM_{2.5} ambient air monitoring data recorded in Libby, Montana from 2018 that were flagged for exclusion because their values were affected (i.e. increased) due to smoke from wildfires. The documentation contains information regarding the monitoring data "flagged" for exclusion. After review, EPA may exclude the flagged PM_{2.5} data for purposes of air quality planning and regulation.
- 4) The Department will accept public comment regarding the both submissions for 30 days. The public comment period begins on October 18, 2019 and ends on November 17, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.
