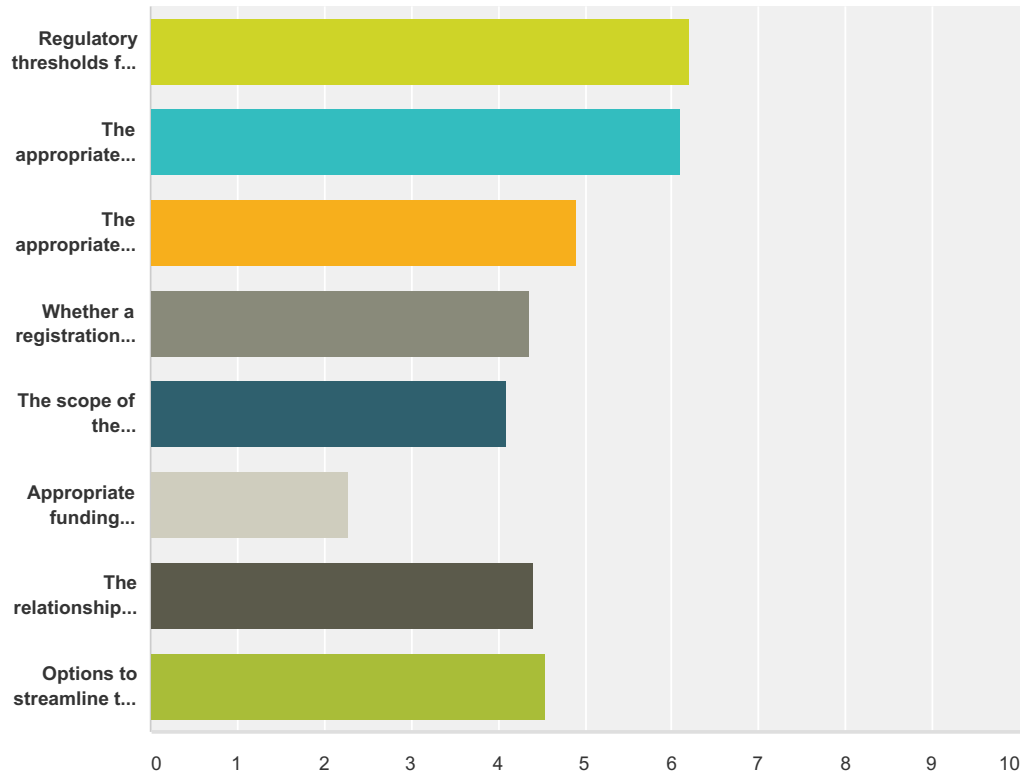

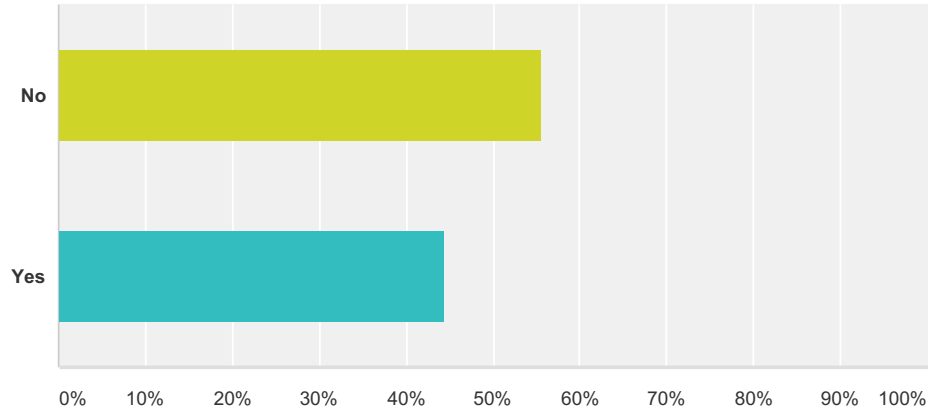

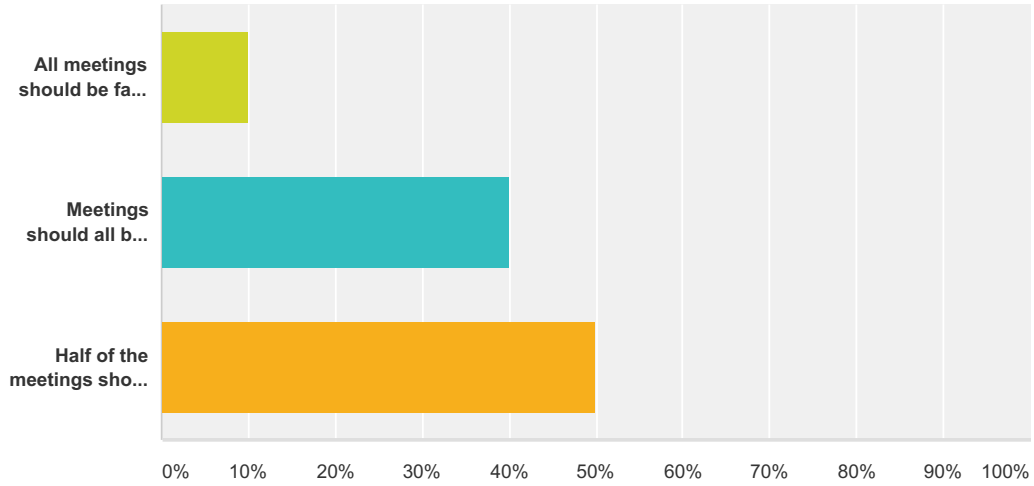

### Q3 How many face to face meetings do you think the Asbestos Advisory Group should have?

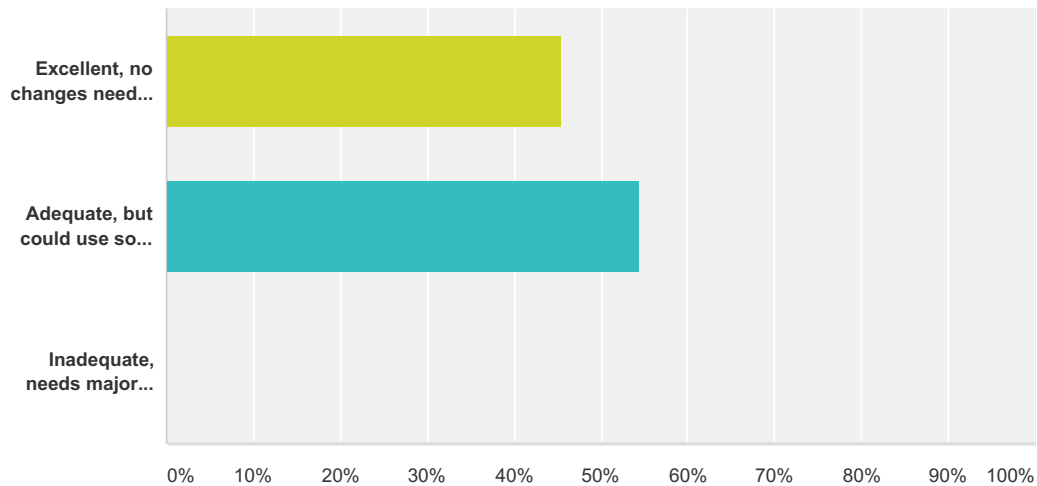

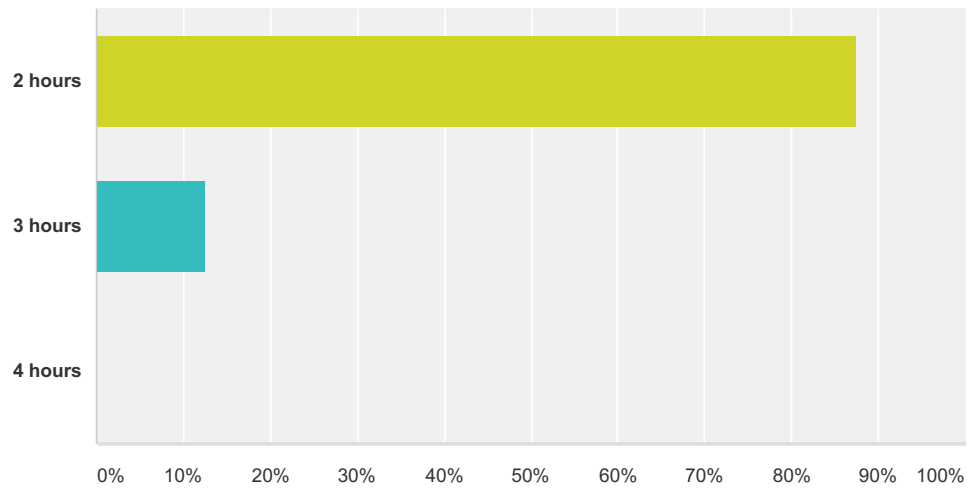

### Q5 How long do you think Asbestos Advisory Group meetings should last?

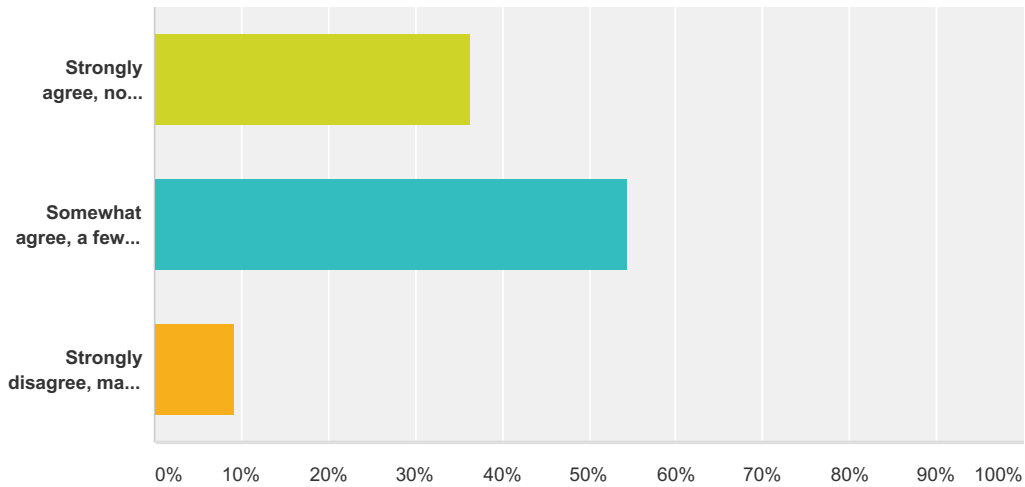

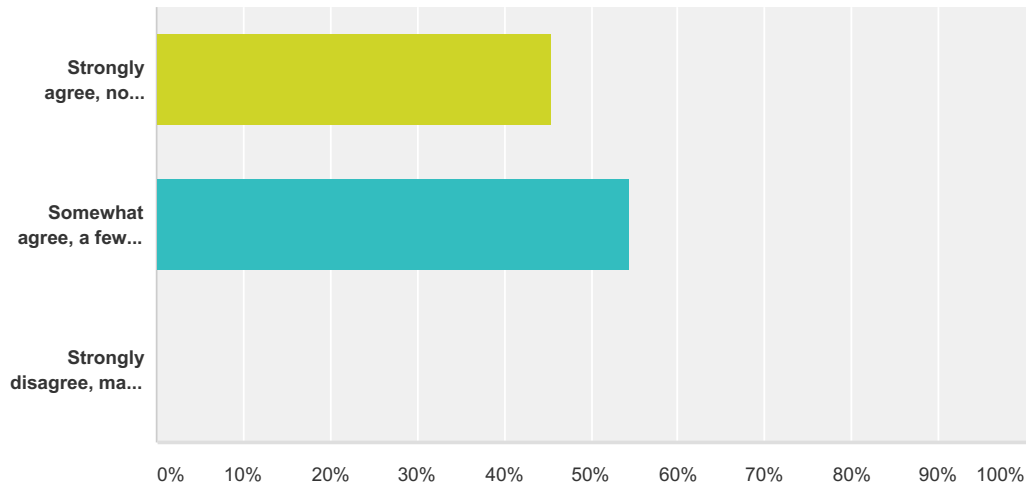

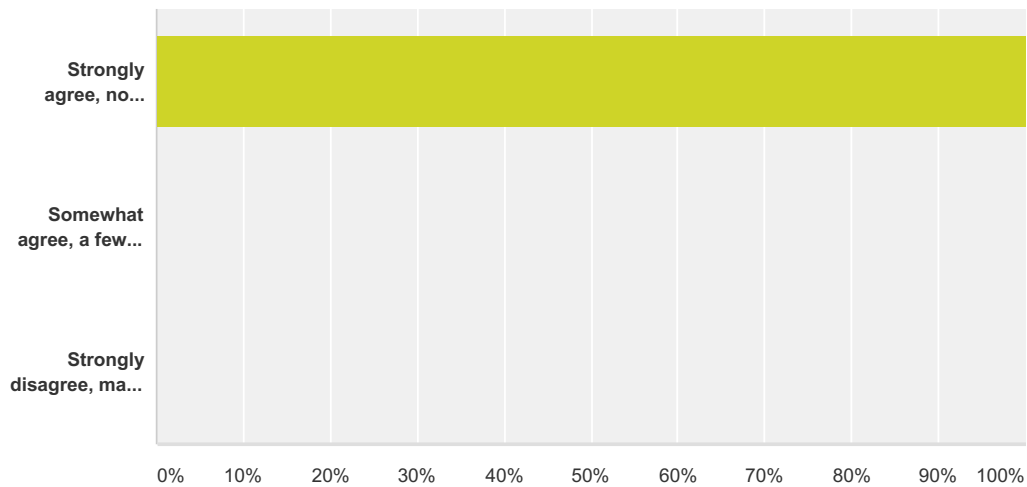

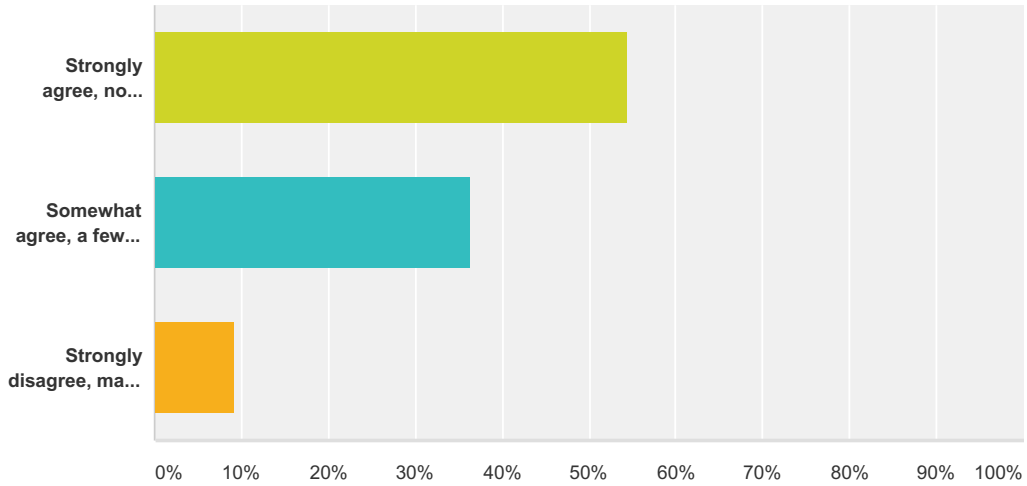

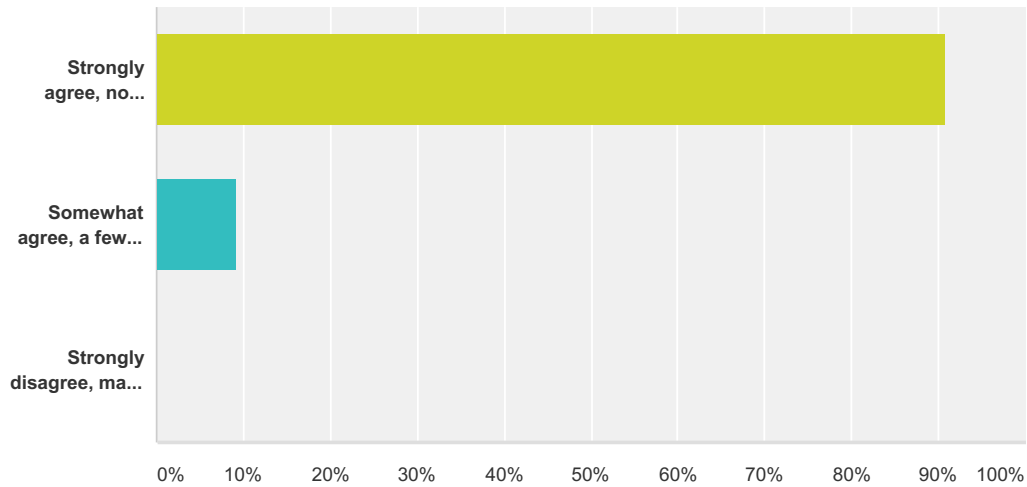

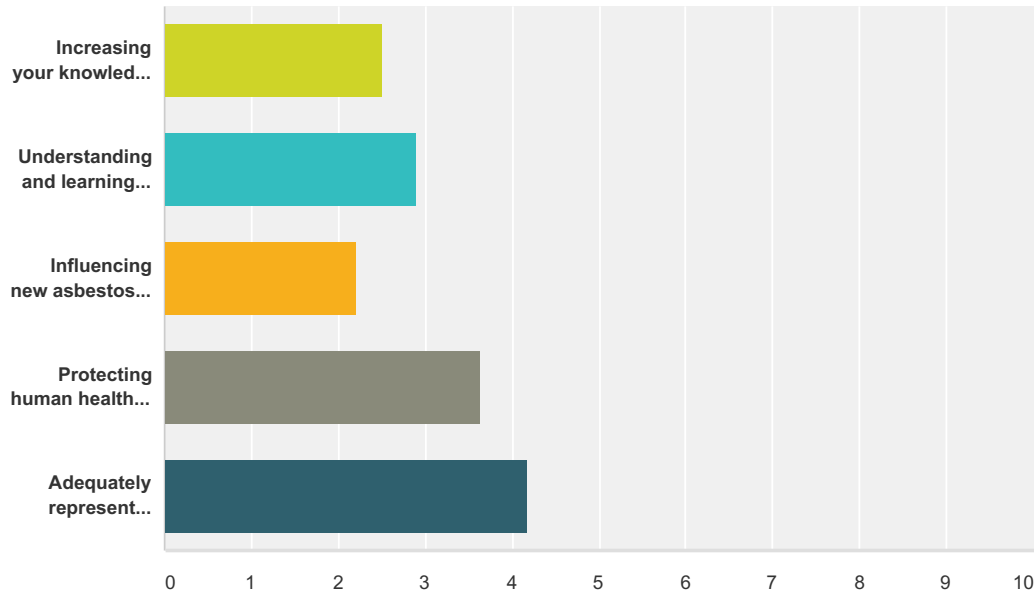

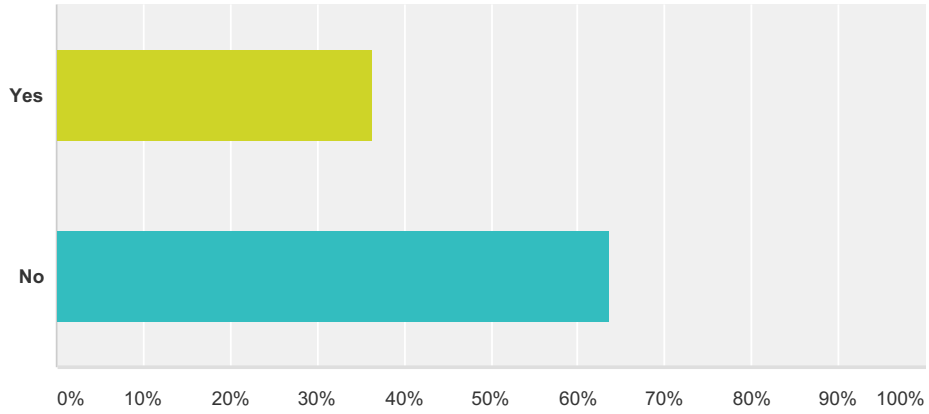
