WATER TOWER RECOATING PROJECT

September 9, 2016

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has reviewed the above-named project. The project consists of repairing and recoating the water storage tank.

The project location is in Opheim, Montana. The elevated water storage tank is located in Opheim Park bounded on the north by 1st Avenue North, on the south by Railroad Avenue, on the west by Willow Street and on the east by Rock Street (see map on DEQ Website under Public Interest tab). The only potential contaminant sources identified within an 880-foot diameter buffer around the construction area were sewer mains which will not be affected by this project.

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA).
