



NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION
RAMSAY COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT
WATER STORAGE TANK REHABILITATION PROJECT

May 3, 2017

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above named project. The project consists of the replacement of the riser pipe supplying water to the elevated steel storage tank that is integral to the public water system serving the community of Ramsay. The elevated steel tank is located 0.41 miles northeast of the I-90 Ramsay Exit 216; coordinates of the tank are 46^o 00' 49.67" North/112^o 40' 38.78" West. Work includes the supply of materials meeting the requirements of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014 relative to the required use of American-made and assembled pipe and other steel components; installation; testing; and disinfection.

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA).



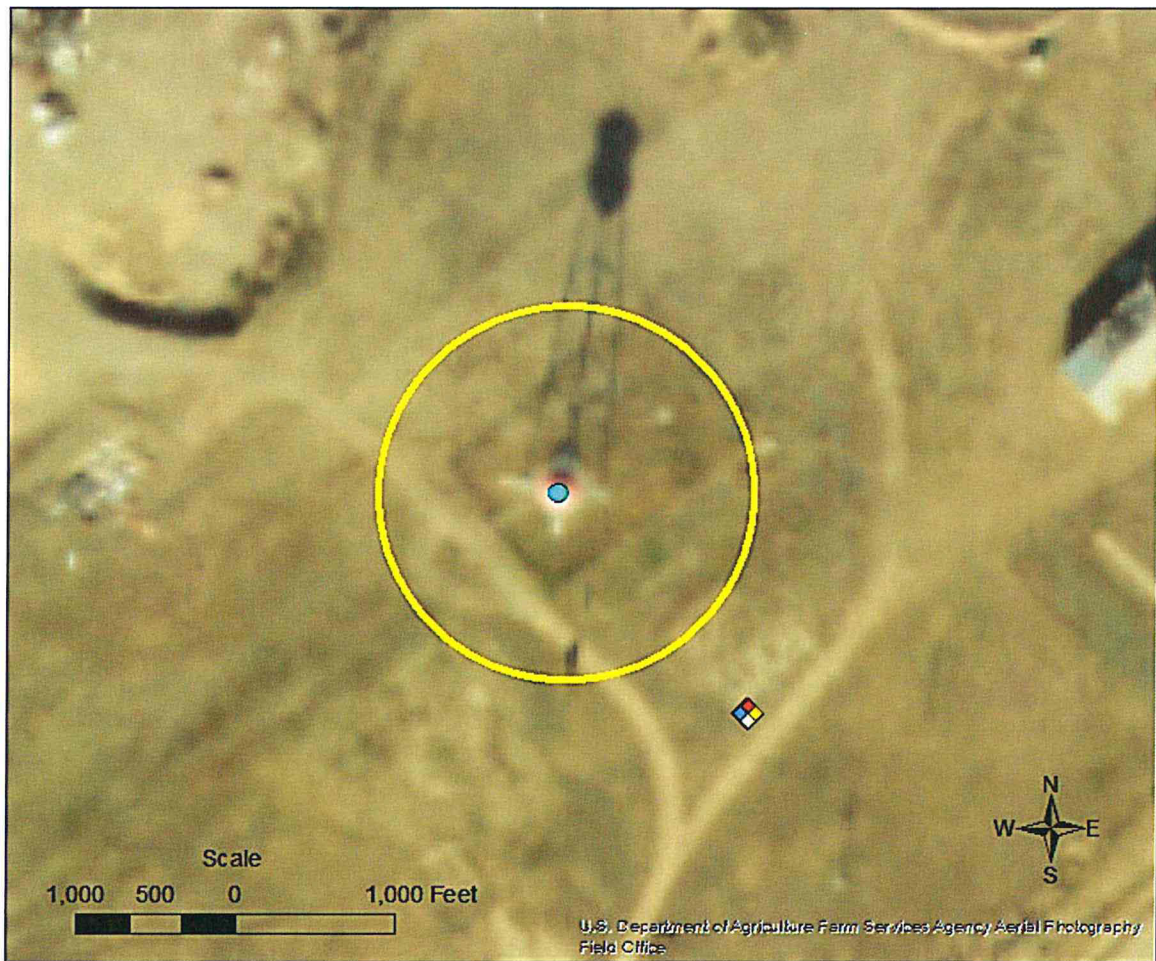
