



NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION
CITY OF ROUNDUP, MONTANA
2016 PHASE 3 WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
SCHEDULE 5 & 6 ADDITION

May 10, 2016

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above named project. The original Phase 3 project consists of replacing approximately 6,600 lineal feet of water main. The notice of categorical exclusion for this work was published March 31, 2016. The City of Roundup has decided to replace additional 2,100 feet of water main during the Phase 3 construction period. This additional work will install 8 to 10-inch PVC and all associated appurtenances and surface repair along the following streets:

- 13th Avenue - between 1st Street West and 2nd Street East
- 6th Avenue - between 4th Street and 7th Street

The project construction specifications note the potential to encounter petroleum contaminated soil or water within the project site and include language on the procedures to follow if this were to occur. Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA).
