



NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION
CITY OF GLENDIVE, MONTANA
Meade Avenue Water and Sewer Replacement Project

November 19, 2018

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above-named project. The project consists of installing approximately, 1,700 lineal feet of 8-inch to 12-inch PVC water main, 1,500 lineal feet of 8-inch sewer main and all associated manholes, valves, fire hydrants, fittings, service lines, service connections, curbs, gutters and road surface restoration. This work is being coordinated with the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) Meade Avenue project. The proposed work will replace aging and undersized water and sewer mains within the following areas:

Water Main Replacement

- Meade Avenue from West Towne Street to West Dodge Street
- West Benham Street at Meade Avenue intersection
- West Borden Street at Meade Avenue intersection

Sewer Main Replacement

- Meade Avenue from West Towne Street to West Dodge

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA). The Categorical Exclusion may be revoked if the project is not initiated within the time period specified in the planning documents, a new or modified application is submitted, or new evidence demonstrates serious local or environmental issues exist, or state, local, tribal, or federal laws are violated.
