

## **VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **FOR THE WATER AND WASTEWATER OPERATOR CERTIFICATION ADVISORY COUNCIL**

The Water and Wastewater Operator's Advisory Council provides program stakeholder review functions. The council is appointed by the Governor and is comprised of seven members (Montana Codes Annotated 2-15-2105). The members are water and wastewater operators, representative of a municipality, a faculty member of a university, and a department representative. Each member shall serve for terms of 6 years. The Council meets at least two times per year: one in person meeting and a phone conference. All travel costs to attend meetings are reimbursed by the Operator Certification Program.

According to state law, applicants for the current open position must meet the following requirements:

- One member serving on the faculty of a university or college (and) whose major field is related to water supply systems, wastewater treatment, chemical or civil engineering, chemistry, or bacteriology (MCA 2-15-2105(2c))
