
The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above-named project. The project consists of installing a degassing system at the Water Treatment Plant and replacing the old and outdated bulk water filling station. The project area consists of the Water Treatment Plant located northwest of the city and the existing bulk water filling station which is located within Conrad city limits.

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA). The Categorical Exclusion may be revoked if the project is not initiated within the time period specified in the planning documents, a new or modified application is submitted, new evidence demonstrates serious local or environmental issues exist, or state, local, tribal, or federal laws are violated.
