

## PUBLIC NOTICE

As required by § 75-10-723, MCA, and in accordance with § 75-10-713, MCA, the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) hereby gives notice of a 30-day public comment period on the Administrative Order on Consent (AOC) it proposes to enter into with the City of Bozeman (City) and CVS Pharmacy, Inc. (CVS) for the Bozeman Solvent Site in Bozeman, Montana. This document requires the City and CVS to implement the final cleanup remedy selected in the Record of Decision (ROD) and reimburse DEQ for its remedial action costs. In March 2011, DEQ solicited public comment on the proposed remedy which is now incorporated in the ROD. The ROD was issued on August 18, 2011 and finalizes DEQ's selection of the appropriate remedial action for the Site. DEQ may withdraw or withhold consent to this AOC or may request changes to the AOC based on the comments received. The public comment period will begin on Thursday, December 8, 2011, and will end on January 6, 2012, at midnight. Copies of the AOC are available for review at DEQ's website, <http://www.deq.state.mt.us/pubcom.asp>, at the Bozeman Public Library at 626 East Main Street in Bozeman, and at DEQ's office at 1100 Last Chance Gulch in Helena. DEQ will hold a public meeting upon written request to DEQ on or before December 23, 2011 by 10 or more persons, a group of 10 or more persons (but not including a liable person), the Gallatin County Commissioners, or by the Mayor and the City Commissioners.
