Compact Fluorescent Light bulbs can be recycled year round at Home Depot and at Ace Hardware until Dec. 2008.

Plastic Shopping Bags are collected for recycling at: Wal-Mart, Albertsons, Safeway, and most other grocery stores.

Electronics can be recycled for a fee of \$10.00 per item at all Staples stores, for a fee at Tatoonie Electronics Systems (861-4920), and at annual E-waste collection events.

Rechargeable Batteries and Cell Phones can be recycled at RadioShack, Ace Home & Garden Center, Industrial Communications & Electronics, Grainger, Fastenal, Zentz Lumber Company, Billings Electronics, Office Depot, Central Hobbies, Ted's Electric Service, King's Ace Hardware, Sears, Sears Repair Services, Batteries Plus, Billings Hardware Company, Home Depot, Verizon

Wireless, Lowe's, OfficeMax, Hughes Supply, Western Tool Supply, Ace Hardware and Thoea Golden Rule Lumber in Laurel.

Car Batteries can be recycled at Wal-Mart, Allied Waste Billings Recycling, Golden Recycling, Batteries Plus, and Master Lube Centers.

Used Motor Oil can be recycled at City of Billings Solid Waste Division, Landfill, Tri State Fluid Recycling, Master Lube Centers, and Oily Waste Recycling.

Pacific Recycling (245-3133) also accepts **copper, stainless steel, insulated copper wire, scrap iron, scrap aluminum, brass, auto radiators, appliances, and auto bodies.**

Curbside Recycling is also available from Earth First Aid. (698-0903)
