Recycling Update – New products recycled at Transfer Station!

New recyclables include:

- **Paperboard**, which is thick paper products – ie: tissue boxes, beverage boxes, cereal boxes, other thick paper containers. Must be clean and dry – no wet food containers. (Put paperboard with corrugated cardboard)
- **Steel (tin) cans** - also rinsed and dry – leave labels on (Separate from aluminum cans)
- **Office paper** (used to be just white office paper) – now you can recycle most paper including junk mail, please discard non-paper items from junk mail. Long shredded paper is OK, leave in bag so it doesn't blow around. No confetti shredded paper, no gift wrap, **no neon, fluorescent or golden rod colored paper**, (these colors contaminate the load).
- **Other plastic containers** – non-bottles, ie: #1 - #7 rigid plastic containers, butter tubs, lids, etc. Must be clean and dry. (No plastic bags, film or wrap.)

The Current Household Recycling List – taken at the Transfer Station:

(Each item in the list is placed a separate container.)

- Newspaper (and everything that comes with it)
- Magazines & Catalogs (glossy paper)
- Phone books (no spiral bindings)
- Office paper
- Corrugated cardboard, paperboard and brown paper bags
- Aluminum cans
- Steel (tin) cans
- #1 Plastic bottles
- #2 Plastic bottles
- #2 Clear milk jugs
- Other plastic containers #1 - #7 (non-bottles)

Also recycled & taken at the Transfer Station:

- Used motor oil and antifreeze
- Lead (vehicle) batteries
- Tires
- Large appliances (which may have or had Freon)
