Plastic Shopping Bags are collected for recycling at: Wal-Mart, Albertsons, Reynolds, St Vincent DePaul, and Great Grains Health Food Store.

Cell Phones are collected at Verizon, Ace Hardware, and Sacred Heart School.

Styrofoam Packing Peanuts/ Bubble Wrap can be recycled at BuyMT.

Computers and Printers -working and non-working are collected at Big Sky Computer Sales and Service.

Inkjet Cartridges are recyclable at Highland Park, Lincoln, Garfield, and Sacred Heart Schools, and at the Custer County Extension Office.

Appliances (non-working) are taken at Ken Stabler Trucking and Custer County Landfill (not in the pit).

Appliances (working) are taken at St. Vincent DePaul Store and Ursuline Convent (call 234-4146 prior for information).

Car Batteries are recyclable at Wal-Mart and Pacific Steel and Recycling.

Rechargeable and Cell Phone Batteries are recyclable at Ace Hardware.

Anti-freeze is taken at Auto Transmission Systems.

Waste oil is recyclable at Wal-Mart and Auto Transmission Systems.

Clothing is taken for resale at EMI (deliver to EMI for Woods and Goods), St Vincent De Paul, and Ursuline Convent.

Eyeglasses are recyclable in boxes at Airport Inn, Dr. Marta King's office, East Montana Vision Center, Miles City Vision Clinic, and through the Lions Club.

Christmas Trees are collected after Christmas at Fish, Wildlife, and Parks and the Custer County Landfill.

Pesticides are collected at a once per year event with the Department of Agriculture and Custer County Extension Office announcing the date.

Medication disposal is conducted twice per year with the Drug Enforcement Agency and Holy Rosary Hospital Pharmacy announcing the dates.
