Did you know an asbestos inspection is required prior to any demolition or renovation project regardless of the building's age? It's true, and probably one of the most over looked environmental regulations to date. However, according to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants, asbestos inspections are in fact required prior to any renovation or demolition project, regardless of the age of the building or size of the project. That means regardless if it was built in 2008 or 1978 or "it's just a little renovation of an office space", you need to have an asbestos survey prior to that up-coming renovation or demolition you have planned.
