DEQ received comments from the City of Shelby during this period requesting revision of the cleanup levels for soil at the facility based on newly released DEQ risk-based screening levels for petroleum contamination. DEQ determined this change is acceptable because it does not significantly modify the plan nor change the selected remedy. DEQ has concluded that the VCP meets the requirements specified in § 75-10-734, MCA and will attain a degree of cleanup and control of hazardous or deleterious substances that complies with the requirements of § 75-10-721, MCA and has approved the plan. The VCP indicates that petroleum-contaminated soils at the facility will be addressed through excavation and off-site disposal and the placement of institutional controls. The VCP is available for review at the Toole County Library in Shelby, and the DEQ Remediation Division office located at 1100 Last Chance Gulch in Helena.
