

SMP Amendment Public Notice Example

Pursuant to the Montana Strip and Underground Reclamation Act notice is hereby given that Navajo Transitional Energy Company, LLC., with its offices located at: 285 Interlocken Crescent, Suite 400 Broomfield, Co 80021 has filed an application with the Coal Section, Mining Bureau of the Department of Environmental Quality for amendment six of Permit Number C1979012.

The Spring Creek Mine is located near Decker, Montana. The general legal description of the amendment area is as follows:
