POST-CONSTRUCTION

Construction is complete on the south side of the Montana Pole & Treating Plant site. Seeding will begin in Spring when the weather warms up.

Envirocon moved soils into an engineered repository and wrapped up construction in September of 2022. DEQ is coordinating with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Butte-Silver Bow to complete title research and survey the property to eventually allow for redevelopment. A portion of the property will remain in DEQ's control to ensure the remedy remains in place.
