On February 28, 2020, the Department of Environmental Quality (department) published MAR Notice No. 17-410 pertaining to the public hearing on the proposed amendment, repeal, and adoption of the above-stated rules at page 354 of the 2020 Montana Administrative Register, Issue Number 4. On March 27, 2020, the department published a supplemental notice at page 525 of the 2020 Montana Administrative Register, Issue Number 6, where the March 24, 2020 informal public meeting was cancelled, and the public hearing was rescheduled to April 29, 2020. Also, the comment period was extended to May 1, 2020.

2. Because there currently exists a state of emergency in Montana due to the public health crisis caused by the coronavirus, on April 29, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., the department will hold a public hearing via remote conferencing for the proposed amendment, repeal, and adoption of the above-stated rules.
