Dear Mr. Thompson:

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) approves Amendment 013 to Golden Sunlight Mine Operating Permit 00065. It has been determined that this is a minor amendment to the operating permit. Enclosed is the environmental assessment. There is one stipulation to the amendment approval, which is:

A Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) will need to be provided for the fine ore concentrate before the flotation plant is put into operation. Additional safety precautions may need to be implemented based on the MSDS and MDOT requirements.

A bond will be calculated by DEQ in the near future.

The Permit boundary will not change and will remain at 6,125 acres. The current disturbance boundary of 3,101 acres will be increased by 0.97 acres to about 3,102 acres.
