The Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ) Junk Vehicle Program received an application for motor vehicle wrecking facility (MVWF). DEQ reviewed the application and determined it is complete. The name and address of the applicant are:

Mr. Russell D. Spalding (applicant), doing business as Spalding Auto Parts, submitted a license application to DEQ's Junk Vehicle Program for the licensure of a MVWF in Missoula County. The proposed location is: 9919 Garrymore Lane, Missoula, Montana. The property is owned by Joseph Fraser, and is leased to the applicant. The applicant applied to license 7.44 acres of the property for use as a MVWF.

This notice informs the public of the proposed action and seeks public participation in the decision-making process.
