Subject: Tentative survey/sampling schedule

Hi Donnie and Gail,

NewFields geologists are planning to complete field work in NE Montana next week. As discussed last week via email, we can travel to Sidney to assist with the field portions of the waste oil release investigation at SREM. Based on the various projects/tasks we need to complete during the week, we are anticipating that we can travel to Sidney on Thurs April 2 to observe and assist with the sheen survey. If no sheen is noted we will plan to sample soil/sediment and water during the same field visit. If a sheen is present on or near the water surface following the survey, we will recommend delaying the sampling until after additional oil removal efforts are completed.

The current NewFields budget for the project includes only one trip to the site. However, the number of hours needed to get the work plan prepared and approved was lower than anticipated. In the event that we need to return at a later date to collect samples, I believe that we will be able to do so within the existing budget, assuming that we will be back in NE MT for other projects in the near future.

At this point, we don't anticipate impacts to this schedule based on the coronavirus situation. We will inform you if this changes.

Please let us know if this sounds reasonable and we will proceed with the plan.
