



Montana Wetland Council Email Survey Results


Q1: Which of these Montana regions best describes where you reside?




Number of Respondents by Region




Population by Region



Q2: Which category best describes your occupation that connects you to wetland issues?






Q3: How important do you believe healthy wetlands are to Montana's environmental health and vitality?




Q4: Over the last 10 years Montana's wetlands have been conserved:
