

Variance Update



Timeline for Variance Rule

- 45-day public comment period started July 8, 2022
 - Following publication of notice in MT administrative register (MAR)
- Public hearing: August 18, 2022
- Department response to comments
- Department Head signs rule no later than September 27, 2022, rule filed no later than September 27, 2022
- Publishes by October 7, 2022



Variance Rule Public Comment

- Comment period ends August 22, 2022
- Public Hearing: August 18 at 10 a.m. via Zoom or in Room 111


