
Montana Department of Environmental Quality Registered Portable Air Quality Emission Source Submission Instructions





Introduction

- To hopefully make the process of registering portable equipment easier, DEQ is moving to an electronic submittal system.
- Operators will no longer submit a pdf with their registration information; the registration will occur through a website.
- The goal is to make the process more efficient for both operators and DEQ staff.



Process


- 1. Operator submits initial operator registration form.
 - This step is not necessary if operator has previously submitted operator registration paperwork.
- 2. DEQ reviews operator registration and approves or denies submission.
 - Operator will receive email from DEQ with approval or denial.
- 3. Operator submits registration information for portable equipment for <u>estimated</u> operating date.
 - Each piece of equipment will get its own registration (i.e. if you have both a crusher and a batch asphalt plant, you will submit a separate registration for each).
- 4. DEQ reviews portable equipment registration and approves or denies submission.
 - Operator will receive email from DEQ with approval or denial.
 - If approved the location will display on the public registration dashboard as pending.
- 5. Operator submits registration information for portable equipment for confirmed operating date.
 - Each piece of equipment will get its own registration (i.e. if you have both a crusher and a batch asphalt plant, you will submit a separate registration for each).
- 6. DEQ reviews portable equipment registration and approves or denies submission.
 - Operator will receive email from DEQ with approval or denial.
 - If approved the location will display on the public registration dashboard as active.
- 7. Operator submits registration information for portable equipment for <u>removal</u> date.
 - Each piece of equipment will get its own removal form (i.e. if you have both a crusher and a batch asphalt plant and are removing both, you will submit a separate removal form for each; if only removing the crusher for example, you will only submit a removal form for the crusher).
- 8. DEQ reviews portable equipment removal.
 - Operator will receive email from DEQ confirming removal.
 - The location will be removed from the public registration dashboard.



- If the operator has previously registered as an operator with DEQ Air Quality Bureau, the initial operator registration can be skipped and go straight to registration of equipment. This includes if you registered the previous way, by submitting a hard copy form or pdf.
- To register as an operator:



- Fill out the Registrant Information section.
 - Owner/Operator Name
 - Company Entity Name (if different than owner/operator name)

 - Additional Information





- Fill out the Source Type Information section.
 - Select Yes/No for each source type (yes if you are registering the specified equipment, no if you are not).





- Fill out the Operating Location section.
 - Indicate if you know the current operating location.

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





No fee is due at the time of registration. Annual operating fees for registered facilities are based on a sliding scale dependent on annual emission rates with a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$13,000 per year. Fee calculations can be found on our website https://deq.mt.gov/Air/Assistance Existing Facilities > Registered Sources.

- Fill out the Certification section.
 - Provide Name of Owner/Operator Designated Representative
 - Provide Title of Designated Representative
 - Provide Notification Date (date you are submitting the form)
 - Provide Signature
- When you have completed filling in all information, click the
 Submit button at the bottom of the form.




- You will see the screen below/left if your registration was successfully submitted.
- DEQ staff will receive an e-mail with your information and will review the submission.
- You will receive an e-mail back from "DEQ sapowerautomate" with approval or denial (example below/right).








- To continue registering the operating equipment, do one of the following (all go to the same form)
 - Click the link in the successful submission window where it says: "Facility Update Notification Form (Attachment A)".
 - Click the link in your approval e-mail for the initial operator registration (if you filled out that form).

1. Important Information



- The owner/operator must submit notice of estimated dates of operation and proposed location(s) for each source type at least 15 days before commencing operation at the
- . DEQ will publish the location after receiving a complete notification on the public portable source registration map.
- The owner/operator must contact DEQ to confirm that the location is active within 10 days of commencing operations at the new location.
- . The owner/operator must notify DEQ within 10 days after removing all equipment of a single source type from a location. DEQ will then remove the source category from the above website.
- Thus, for each source type at an operating location, this form should be submitted on three separate occasions: estimated operation dates (15 days prior to operation); confirmed operating dates (10 days prior to operation); removal dates (10 days after removal)


Administrative Rules of Montana Title 17, Chapter 8, Subchapter 18




- Fill out the Notice of Operating Location section.
 - Provide the location of your facility/equipment.
 - You can enter in coordinates or an address in the search bar, or you can pan and zoom around the map to set your location. The blue dot on the map is where your location has been set. You can change the location by clicking the map.
 - The county field will auto-populate based on where you click on your map.
 - Provide the facility/location name.
 - Identify the location type (permanent or temporary).
 - Identify if the location is within sage grouse habitat. If yes, provide the date you consulted with the Montana Sage Grouse Program regarding your facility/location.




- Fill out the Source Type section.
 - Select the Source Type to be operated at the location.
 - If registering multiple source types, you will submit a form for each source type.
 - Select the Notification Type you are submitting for and the relevant dates.
 - You must first submit the estimated operating dates.
 - When you know the confirmed operating date, you will then submit this form again, picking confirmed operating date as the notification type.
 - When you are ready to remove the equipment, you will then submit this form again, picking removal date as the notification type.
 - Thus, for a single new emission source, you will submit this form three times: one for the estimated operating date, once for the confirmed operating date, and once for the removal date. You will do this for each source type you are registering.



- Fill out the Certification section.
 - Select the Owner/Operator.
 - If your owner/operator name is not listed, it means you have not completed the initial owner/operator registration form described earlier in this document. You will need to complete this form before registering your equipment.
 - Provide Name of Owner/Operator Designated Representative
 - Provide Title of Designated Representative
 - Provide Phone Number
 - Provide E-Mail
 - Provide Notification Date (date you are submitting the form)
 - Provide Signature
- When you have completed filling in all information, click the
 Submit button at the bottom of the form.




- You will see the screen below/left if your registration was successfully submitted.
- Click the link if you need to submit a form for additional source locations
- DEQ staff will receive an e-mail with your information and will review the submission.
- You will receive an e-mail back from "DEQ sapowerautomate" with approval or denial (example below/right). You
 will receive an email for each notification type you submit for (i.e. estimated operating dates, confirmed dates, and
 removal dates).





Public Registration Dashboard/Map

- You can view the locations of pending (estimated operating dates) and active (confirmed operating dates) source locations on the public registration dashboard map.

 - You can use the filters on the left side of the map to narrow down the locations displayed on the map.
