



Bridger Pipeline Expansion (BPE) has notified the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) of the intent to submit an Application for a Certificate of Compliance under the Major Facility Siting Act (MFSA). BPE anticipates submitting the Application to DEQ on or about February 27, 2026. You are receiving this notice as the proposed pipeline either crosses or lies in close proximity to a property listed in your name.

The proposed project is a 36-inch diameter steel crude oil pipeline traversing Phillips, Valley, Daniels, Sheridan, Roosevelt, Richland, Wibaux, Fallon and Carter counties.

DEQ's review of the Application will involve the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to satisfy the environmental review requirements of both MFSA and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA). That process will also include opportunities for public review and comment on the proposal. You will receive notice of a public scoping meeting which is anticipated to occur within the next two months.
