What made you decide to buy an electric vehicle?

Not having to get gas. Pumping gas is a surreal activity. No one notices because it's something people just do every two weeks and they've gotten used to it. But if you haven't done it for six months and then do it, you discover that it just feels wrong in so many ways.

Have you had any problems with it during the winter?

No, it's been absolutely fabulous. Best car for winter driving I've ever had... handling, responsiveness, traction, instantaneous cabin heat, etc.

Would you recommend an EV to someone considering buying a new car?

Absolutely. I'd contend that there are extremely limited (valid) reasons to buy anything else... if they aren't ready to buy an EV now I can at least make a cogent

argument... to stick with their current car until things develop.

What advice would you give to someone considering buying an electric vehicle?

The best advice I can give is to get access to one and drive it exclusively for a week. If someone is already considering buying one, driving it for a week will absolutely convince them.

Have you ever taken it on a trip? If so, where to?
