Comprehensive Bond Review for Steve Stoican (Hard Rock Mining Operating Permit No. 00180)

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is conducting a comprehensive bond review for Operating Permit No. 00180 issued to Steve Stoican. Steve Stoican's facility and associated disturbances are located in Section 11, Township 5 North, Range 18 East, about 10 miles southwest of Ryegate, MT, in Golden Valley County.

DEQ has determined that the current bonding level does not represent the present costs of compliance with the Metal Mine Reclamation Act, administrative rules adopted thereunder, and the operating permit. DEQ is proposing a bond increase of \$19,828 (from \$39,034 to \$58,862). The bond increase is largely due to changes in revegetation and weed control rates, fuel price and equipment rates, additional disturbance area, and updated indirect costs including mobilization, contingency, and administration.

The procedure for adjusting bonds as a result of a comprehensive bond review is set forth in Section 82-4-338(3), MCA. The permittee and the public will have until July 1, 2025, to comment on the proposed bond increase. DEQ will issue a final bond determination after the comment period has expired. The permittee, or any person with an interest that may be adversely affected by DEQ's final bond determination, may obtain a contested case hearing before the Board of Environmental Review. A written request for a hearing must be filed with DEQ within 30 days of the issuance of the final bond determination, stating the reason for the request.
