SUBJECT: COMMERCIAL TRANSFER FACILITY ANNUAL REPORT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024

General Information

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) records show that you have registered as a hazardous waste transfer facility and meet the requirements of a commercial transfer facility. Pursuant to the Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM) 17.53.708, an owner or operator of a commercial transfer facility must prepare and submit a Commercial Transfer Facility Annual Report by March 1 of each year. The annual report must include information on activities conducted at the commercial transfer facility during the previous calendar year. The annual report must include the following information:

- 1. The EPA Identification Number, Name, and Address of the commercial transfer facility.
- 2. The calendar year covered by the report.
- 3. A summary of all hazardous wastes the commercial transfer facility handled during the report year, organized by EPA hazardous waste number. Quantitative waste amounts must be included for each waste type.
- 4. A written summary of each hazardous waste leak, spill, fire, or similar incident that occurred during the report year, including the response actions taken, the cause of the incident, and a legible copy of the pertinent waste manifest(s) for disposal of the hazardous waste involved in the incident.
- 5. A certification signed and dated by the owner or operator of the commercial transfer facility or an authorized representative.
