- o Permitting
 - Permitting data compiled from 2023 2025
 - Comparing applications received from listed years
 - Statutory, Non-Statutory and Referred Complaints
- Annual Production Reports
 - Updated the correspondence
 - Sent reports to 477 operators,
 - Scheduled to send administrative deficiency letters to 111 operators
 - Violation letters go out April 21st and referred to enforcement may 26.
- Proposed Changes to Applications
 - Optional MEPA questions have been delayed until legislative session, MEPA bills are in process
 - We notify when our forms have been updated, we send an email to the stakeholder list and operator list
 - Reminder to download the newest forms every submittal
- Questions (Form updates):
 - Updates occur on a quarterly basis
- Release Requests
 - Bailey
 - Release Requests are completed in tow phases, release request requirements, they may require inspections

- Common deficiencies on releases,
 - Missing information, lack of information, missing photos, lack of vegetation, incorrect land use
- Public Participation
 - The public comment period is throughout the permitting process,
 - The operator is responsible for public notification
 - Operators can request public comments about their site at any time throughout the permitting process
 - DEQ reviews all comments we receive
- Inspection Season
 - Focusing on dryland sites, sites with no reclamation dates and others
 - Maintain a relationship with landowners
- Stakeholder Input
 - Mike Newton, Inspections
 - Inspections completed in a more convenient manner. Worried about permitting timeline, usage of tax payer dollars
 - Trips will be planned accordingly, and the new sites will be matched with normal inspections to ensure applications followed through with.
 - Increase in inspections
 - Multiple sites have been unvisited, there have been violations issued and there is a field presence needed
 - Is the plan to notify operators of inspections
 - We try to notify the operator if available, not always the consultants.
