



the waste station — every poop counts.

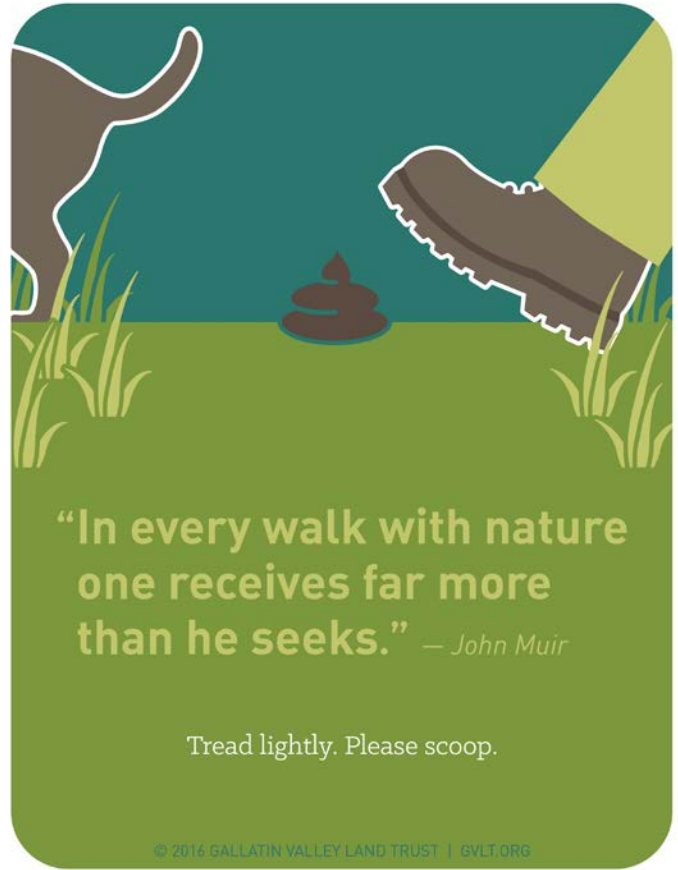

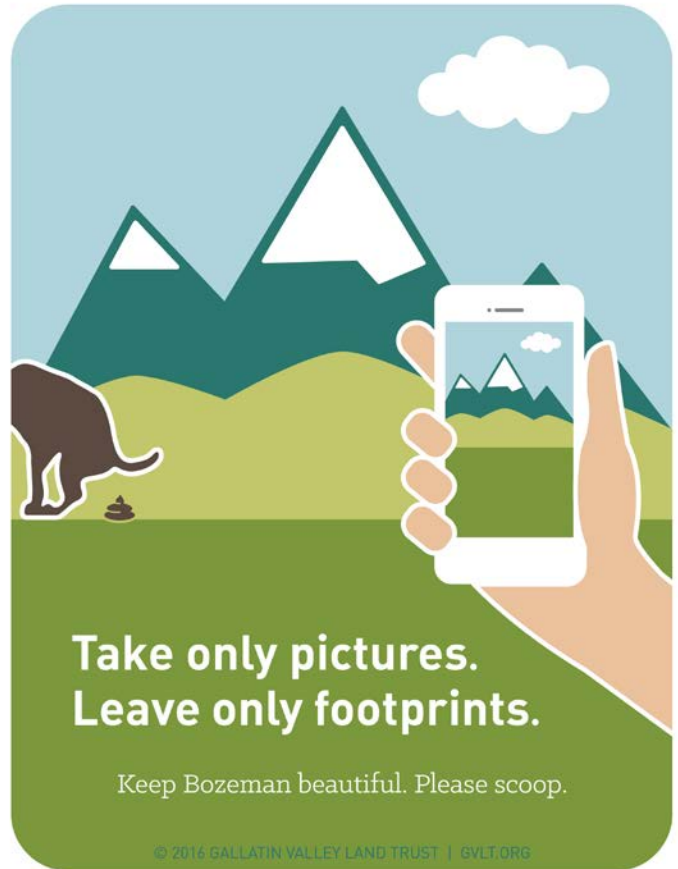
