The most recent MPDES Produced Water General Permit (PWGP), MTG310000 became effective on December 1, 2021 with an expiration date of November 30, 2026.

Through this minor modification, DEQ is updating Section II.E.3 and Section II.E.4 of the PWGP. The reports for new and existing permittees not discharging at the time of their NOI submission will be due **January 28 and July 28** of each year until new discharge commences. DEQ is also correcting typographical errors in the PWGP.
