PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this notice is to state the Department's intention to issue a General Permit as described in this notice and to hold a public hearing on the issuance of this permit. This permit is issued by the Department under the authority of 75-5-402, Montana Code Annotated (MCA); the Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM) 17.30.1301 *et seq.*, Montana Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (MPDES); and Sections 402 and 303 of the Federal Clean Water Act. The Water Protection Bureau has prepared a draft permit for the facility listed below. <u>APPLICANT INFORMATION</u>

PERMIT/CATEGORY: Disinfected Water & Hydrostatic Testing General Permit

GEOGRAPHIC REGION: Statewide

FACILITIES: Disinfected Water & Hydrostatic Testing Operations

RECEIVING WATERS: State Surface Water

PERMIT NUMBER: MTG770000

The renewal of this General Permit will continue to provide statewide general permit coverage for owners/operators of disinfected water and hydrostatic testing operations that discharge to state surface waters. The renewal is for a five-year cycle.

The General Permit allows disinfected water and hydrostatic testing operations that meet effluent limits and other conditions specified in the permit to discharge to state surface waters. The General Permit includes effluent limitations for Total Residual Chlorine (TRC), Total Suspended Solids (TSS), pH, Benzene, Toluene, Ethylbenzene, Xylenes (total), and oil & grease and monitoring requirements for flow. In addition, the draft permit includes a requirement for erosion control through installation and maintenance of Best Management Practices.
