## NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION DRY REDWATER RWA WATER MAIN EXTENSION PHASE 1

March 20, 2025

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above-named project. The project consists of the installation of approximately 6,624 lineal feet of 3-inch high density polyethylene (HDPE) water main and nine (9) rural water assemblies near the city of Sidney, Montana. Work will also include typical water main appurtenances including air release valves/hydrants, gate valves, and surface restoration. The project will provide a safe, reliable supply of water to the residents served by Dry Redwater RWA water system.

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA). The Categorical Exclusion may be revoked if the project is not initiated within the time period specified in the planning documents, a new or modified application is submitted, new evidence demonstrates serious local or environmental issues exist, or state, local, tribal, or federal laws are violated.


