Proposed changes to ARM 17.30.10

- 1. Clarify that permitting threshold is based on whole development
- 2. Revise the permit exclusion threshold from 5K gpd to 1 lb/day TN
- 3. Update and modernize public notice procedures
- 4. Administrative cleanup

Public comment is open now on DEQ site

1. Close the loophole Example 57 home subdivision, three 4,750 gpd drainfields Permit NOT required because each system is <5,000 gpd x19 Conventional septic (50 mg/L): 1.99 lbs/day TN Conventional septic (50 mg/L): 1.99 lbs/day TN x19 Conventional septic (50 mg/L): 1.99 lbs/day TN 14,250 gpd & 6 lbs/day TN



1. Without cumulative clarifier



12 public systems of <5,000 gallons per day: ~55K gpd, 23 lbs/day TN



1. Without cumulative clarifier



26,000 gpd wastewater need met by 6 public systems of 4,334 gpd: 10.9 lbs/day TN



2. Revised permitting threshold

Change from 5,000 gallons to 1 pound total nitrogen per day

Based on nitrogen load, not flow volume

More accurately addresses the parameter of concern

NO CHANGE: Only applies to public sewage systems

Multi-family and individual systems are not subject to permits

Only applies to domestic wastewater

There is no threshold for sources of industrial wastewater








2. Translating the threshold

For a Level 2 system, the only change is how the threshold is expressed





2. Proposed threshold

- Example public system serving 19 homes
- 4,750 gallons per day

x19

x19

Permit MAY BE required

Conventional septic (50 mg/L): 1.99 lbs/day TN

Level 2 system (24 mg/L): 0.95 lbs/day TN x19

Advanced N removal (7.5 mg/L): 0.30 lbs/day TN



Other Revisions

3. Update public notice procedures

- Remove 30-day wait for public hearings
- Modernize public notice process
- Revise notified agencies (Federal)
- 4. Administrative cleanup
- Additional definitions for clarity
- Provide for administrative continuance and obligation to raise issues (mirroring MPDES)
