WHEN IN DOUBT, STAY OUT

Harmful algal blooms can resemble



Do NOT go into water that:

- Looks discolored
 Smells bad
- Has scum, dead fish, or mats of algae

Symptoms in humans

- Rash Stomach pain Vomiting
- Headache Coughing Diarrhea
- Irritations of eyes, nose or throat Liver damage
- Seizure Irregular heartbeat

If you have symptoms

Contact your health care provider.

Call Poison Control: 1-800-222-1222.

Symptoms in animals

- Vomiting
 Diarrhea
 Loss of energy
- Staggered walking Excessive drooling Seizure
- Death within hours or days

If your animal has been exposed

Rinse them with clean water immediately to prevent them from licking algae off their fur.
