Over the last several months, the Department of Environmental Quality Asbestos Control Program (DEQ) staff requested copies of paperwork associated with permitted projects. DEQ's goal was to ensure compliance with the reporting requirements identified in Montana Administrative Rules and NESHP guidelines.
